

CALL FOR FINANCIAL SUPPORT – MARCH 2026 INTAKE

The Institut Catholique de Kabgayi (ICK) in collaboration with **CHANCEN International Rwanda** is pleased to announce a funded opportunity (**Tuition Fees only**) for those in need of financial support. The *CHANCEN Income Share Agreement (ISA)* covers your tuition fees during your study period, and once you graduate, you will be expected to pay back a portion of your income when you start earning (Study Now-Pay Later Scheme).

Prospective candidates are invited to apply for the following programs:

- ✓ Bachelor in Rural and Urban Development
- ✓ Bachelor in Environmental Management
- ✓ Bachelor in Journalism
- ✓ Bachelor in Public Relations

Eligibility Criteria:

- ✓ Being a Rwandan
- ✓ Being female is an advantage
- ✓ Having General Advanced certificate of secondary Education with an average pass mark of 50% and above permitting entry to higher education. Students who completed S6 before 2024 should have at least 2 Principal Passes. Those who studied secondary school abroad will present a certificate of equivalence.

The application file must comprise:

- ✓ A notarized copy of Advanced General Certificate of Secondary Education or Results slip of A Level national examination
- ✓ A copy of National Identity Card
- ✓ One colored passport photo

The students who are interested and need CHANCEN International Rwanda's financial support should apply online at www.uck.ac.rw and upload the application documents.

The deadline is **January 17, 2026**.

Note: Those who will be admitted, they will be required to meet CHANCEN Income Share Agreement requirements and attend ISA Workshop with their guardians before the date of starting classes. Those who will be granted CHANCEN's financial support will be communicated by ICK and will start the class with the March intake.
